COURSE I

Renaissance Civilisation

(Irish History, 1477-1625; European History, 1453-1618)

Answer FIVE QUESTIONS, taking only ONE question from each of the sections A,B,C,D,E.

A.1. Life in Ireland c. 1500

Discuss the differences between life in Gaelic Ireland and in the Pale.

A.2. The Butlers of Ormond

Consider the role the Butlers of Ormond played in Irish affairs up to the death of Henry VIII in 1547.

A.3. Henry VIII and Ireland

Treat of relations between Ireland and Henry VIII in the period, 1509 – 1547.

A.4. Religious Change

Discuss religious change in Ireland from the Reformation Parliament, 1536, to Edward VI's death in 1553.

A.5. Mary Tudor, 1553 – 1558

Assess the impact of Queen Mary Tudor's reign on Ireland.

B.1. The Counter-Reformation

Discuss the view that the Counter-Reformation was largely successful in Ireland.

B.2. European Powers and Ireland

Treat of the role European powers played in Irish affairs during the reign of Elizabeth I.

B.3. Plantations

Account for the policy of plantation in Munster and Ulster in the late 16^{th} century and early 17^{th} century and discuss the effects of these plantations.

B.4. Hugh O'Neill, c. 1550 – 1616

Evaluate the career of Hugh O'Neill.

B.5. James I, 1603 – 1625

Treat of the role of James I, 1603 – 1625, in Irish history.

C.1. Portugal

Discuss Portugal's role in the voyages of discovery and in establishing colonies, in the 15th and 16th centuries.

C.2. Louis XI, 1461 – 1483

Treat of the importance of Louis XI's reign, 1461 – 1483, in French history.

C.3. Florence

Discuss the importance of Florence in the Italian Renaissance.

(80)

C.4. The Northern Renaissance

Explain the various ways in which the Northern Renaissance differed from the Italian Renaissance.

C.5. The Ottoman Empire

"More than a century of Ottoman expansion in Europe was brought to a halt by the Battle of Lepanto, 1571."

Discuss.

D.1. The Reformation in Germany

Treat of the spread of Lutheranism in Germany.

D.2. The Council of Trent

Evaluate the importance of the Council of Trent and the decisions that it made.

D.3. Philip II, 1556 – 1598

"Spain's eclipse as a great power originated in the reign of Philip II."

Discuss.

D.4. French Wars of Religion

"French history in the latter half of the sixteenth century was almost continuously strife-ridden." Discuss.

Treat of the causes of the Thirty Years War.

Answer FIVE QUESTIONS, taking only ONE question from each of the sections A,B,C,D,E.

A.1. The Land Question

"The Conservatives did more than the Liberals to solve the 'land question' during the period, 1870 – 1914." Discuss.

A.2. Butt and Parnell

"It took the realism, discipline and leadership of Parnell to complete the work which Butt had begun." Discuss.

A.3. Ulster Unionism

Discuss the role and impact of Ulster Unionism on Irish affairs, 1885 – 1920.

A.4. Cultural Nationalism

Assess the contribution of the various Irish-Ireland movements to Irish history up to 1916.

A.5. The Labour Movement

Treat of the origins and development of the Irish Labour movement up to 1914.

B.1. The Irish Economy

Treat of the fortunes of the Irish economy during the period 1922 - 1948.

B.2. Eamon de Valera

How far did de Valera dismantle the Anglo-Irish Treaty of 1921 during the period, 1932 – 1938?

B.3. Irish Neutrality

Discuss the problems encountered by the Irish government as a result of its policy of neutrality in the years, 1939 - 1945.

B.4. Irish Governments, 1948 – 1966

How successful were Irish governments of the period 1948 – 1966 in dealing with the challenges which faced the country at that time?

B.5. Northern Ireland

Treat of the history of Northern Ireland during the period, 1920 – 1966.

C.1. Church-State Relations, 1870 – 1914

Treat of Church-State relations, during the period 1870 – 1914, in TWO of the following countries: Germany, France, Italy.

C.2. Great Britain, 1870 – 1914

Outline the political, social and economic reforms enacted in Great Britain during the period, 1870 – 1914.

C.3. France, 1870 – 1914

Treat of the challenges to, and the achievements of, the French Third Republic during the period, 1870 – 1914.

C.4. World War I

"The causes of World War I were many and complex."

Discuss.

C.5. Russia, 1917 – 1924

Explain the unfolding of events in Russia from the Bolshevik revolution, October 1917, up to the death of Lenin in March 1924.

D.1. The League of Nations

Treat of the origins and aims of the League of Nations and consider its history during the period, 1920 – 1939.

D.2. Weimar Germany

Treat of the history of the Weimar Republic, 1919 – 1933, giving particular attention to political crises, economic problems and cultural achievements.

D.3. Benito Mussolini

Analyse the part played by Benito Mussolini in the history of Italy.

D.4. USSR, 1953 – 1966

Analyse developments in the USSR from the death of Stalin, 1953, to the year 1966.

Account for the moves made towards European unity in the years, 1945 to 1966.
